

HOW TO JOIN THE PoliMUNDUS NETWORK

As a Researcher

REQUIREMENTS

You should work as an academic or researcher in one of the PoliMundus partners (<http://polimundus.webs.upv.es/members/>) and be active in one of the network research areas:

- Advanced Materials and nanotechnology
- Aerospace engineering
- Information and Communication Technologies
- Sustainability
- Bioengineering

PROCESS

Prepare your curriculum in one (or if possible all) of the following web portals:

- Researcher ID: <http://www.researcherid.com/>
- ORCID ID: <http://orcid.org/>
- Research Gate: <https://www.researchgate.net/home>

The first two are equivalent and the publications can be easily transferred from one to the other. The last one provides a dynamic link to a wide international community of researchers focused to your profile priorities.

Send an e-mail to the coordinator of the PoliMundus network at your University (<http://polimundus.webs.upv.es/members/>) stating the research area on which you are active and your personal web links to the above mentioned web portals (at least one).

You will receive on return your user and password to the PoliMundus intranet, the LinkedIn PoliMundus Group (<https://www.linkedin.com/groups/8463609/profile>), and be connected to the rest of active PoliMundus researchers. You will have to select which researchers you want to follow.

ACTIVITIES

Once connected to the network you will receive bimonthly summaries of program calls where the network is active (relevant to your profile) as well as links to search for partners launched from researchers who you are following.

Grant offers will be published relevant to each Research group, and mentoring support will be offered by the network members.

Those communities wishing to launch an activity will be institutionally given easier procedures for launching projects.

PoliMundus will organize yearly events per research area and this forum will be the chance for discussing future network activities.
